

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF PASCAGOULA, MISSISSIPPI  
DECLARING CERTAIN ITEMS PERSONAL PROPERTY TO BE SURPLUS**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of Pascagoula owns a number of fire hydrants that are no longer in service; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Pascagoula has determined that a number of these fire hydrants are no longer of any value to the City, do not serve a useful function, and are not required for the continued effective operation of the business of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, because these fire hydrants are no longer of any value to the City, three of them shall be removed from the City’s inventory, and donated to Jackson County, Mississippi’s Recreation Department for use in a new off-leash dog area at Lum Cumbest Park in the East Central area, per the attached request from the Jackson County Board of Supervisors Recreation Department.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** That City Council of Pascagoula, Mississippi, hereby declares the three fire hydrants are in fact surplus property, of no value to the City, and are no longer needed for the effective functioning of the City and conduct of City business.

**SECTION 2.** That City Council of Pascagoula, Mississippi, hereby declares said items shall be removed from the City’s inventory of fixed assets, and donated to Jackson County, Mississippi’s Recreation Department.
