



PASCAGOULA RECREATION COMMISSION
MEETING March 6, 2019

Jay Spradlin opened the meeting at 6:25 pm.

Michael Henderson made the motion to approve February minutes as presented. Joe Ezell seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Old Business:

Prepared Food Tax Collection: Jay Spradlin presented the prepared food tax collection information. \$2,011,919.86 has been received from 2/2017-2/14/2019. The receipts collected in February were \$85,991.79.

Project Update:

Flagship Park - Sports Complex –Demolition project is complete with a few remaining items on a punch list. Site work contract is underway. Rain and wet site conditions have kept the dirt work from proceeding. However, one field has been cut down to subhead and the contractor is currently undercutting the corridor for the baseball fields to build a haul road to bring in the require fill and limestone.

This contract has a milestone of mid-August to have sod in place to provide ample time to grow in before going dormant for the winter. Buildings package bids will be opened on March 12th at 2:00 pm. Once we have this bid in we can analyze the budget and see if any of the other alternates can be added to the site contract. We anticipate the buildings starting in April and wrapping up in January.
