

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF PASCAGOULA, MISSISSIPPI
REQUESTING THE MISSISSIPPI LEGISLATURE TO FILE LEGISLATION
ON BEHALF OF THE CITY DURING THE 2021 SESSION**

WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 3027, approved by the Governor during the 2017 Regular Session, authorizes the City of Pascagoula to establish a two percent (2%) tax on certain prepared foods; and

WHEREAS, the proceeds of said tax are and shall be used to fund the City of Pascagoula's Parks & Recreation Master Plan and to make payments on the 2017 Recreation Bond; and

WHEREAS, the current legislation authorizing said tax is set to be repealed on July 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Pascagoula desires that said tax, and the legislation authorizing the same, be reinstated for an additional period of time and that the legislation's repealer be extended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The City Council of Pascagoula hereby adopts the foregoing recitals as its findings.

SECTION 2: The City Council of Pascagoula hereby requests that the Mississippi Legislature reinstitute Senate Bill No. 3027 (2017 Regular Session) and extend the repealer contained therein for the maximum period as determined by the Legislature.
