**ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION FOR RELEASE OF TRUST INTEREST**

This application came before the Secretary of State of Mississippi, Division of Regulation and Enforcement, (hereafter “Division”), in accordance with the authority granted in Mississippi Code Annotated § 21-19-11, requesting the use of perpetual care trust interest for long term capital improvements to Jackson County Memorial Park in Pascagoula, Mississippi (hereinafter “Jackson County”). The Undersigned, having reviewed the request and finding the request will advance and extend the perpetual care life of Jackson County without undue risk to the solvency of Jackson County’s perpetual care trust fund and being satisfied that all notice and hearing requirements have been met, hereby grants the application for release of trust interest and ORDERS the Trustee to release trust interest in accordance with the following:

1. For the purpose of asphalt repairs to include saw-cut, asphalt removal, and asphalt installation, as set forth in the plan received by the Division from the City of Pascagoula. This is the only purpose for which funds may be removed from Jackson County’s perpetual care trust interest consistent with this Order. The authorization for this purpose as set forth in the Order expires July 1, 2022.

2. No more than Eighteen Thousand, One Hundred Seven Dollars (\$18,107.00) may be released from the interest of Jackson County’s perpetual care trust for this project.

3. Documentation of funds released from trust in accordance with this Order and that such funds were used for the purpose stated above must be submitted to the Division no more than thirty (30) days after completion of the project.
