

**RECESSED REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
TUESDAY, MAY 28, 2019, AT 6:00 P. M.  
CITY HALL, PASCAGOULA, MISSISSIPPI**

The City Council of the City of Pascagoula, Mississippi, met at City Hall in a recessed regular meeting on Tuesday, May 28, 2019, at 6:00 p.m. Mayor Maxwell called the meeting to order with the following officials present:

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Mayor Maxwell welcomed everyone to the meeting. The invocation was given by Councilman Fornett. The pledge of allegiance was led by Councilman Parker.

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Frank Corder, Assistant City Manager, facilitated the projects workshop.

Jaci Turner, City Engineer, led discussion to determine Council's priority of potential City infrastructure projects. The Council scored and prioritized the potential projects presented by Ms. Turner and the top three are as follows: Boxwood Drainage Improvements; Buena Vista/Williams Water, Sewer, Storm Drain Upgrades; and Briarwood Drainage Improvements.

Frank Corder, Assistant City Manager, led discussion to determine Council's priority of City roads in most need of paving and striping. The Council determined its priority roads, and authorized a request be made to the Jackson County Board of Supervisors for paving funds. The priority list is as follows: 1) Old Mobile Highway, from Market Street to Chicot Street; 2) Belair Street, from Ingalls Avenue to Washington Avenue; 3) Pascagoula Street, from Highway 90 to Beach Boulevard; 4) Ingalls Avenue, from Market Street to Louise Street; and 5) Beach Boulevard, from The Point to Washington Avenue.

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There being no further business to come before the Council tonight, Councilman Parker made a motion to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Councilman Jones and received the following vote: Mayor Maxwell "AYE", Councilmen Colmer "AYE", Jones "AYE", Fornett "AYE", Burrow "AYE", Parker "AYE", and Tipton "AYE".
