

**RECESSED REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
MONDAY, AUGUST 14, 2017, AT 4:15 P. M.
CITY HALL, PASCAGOULA, MISSISSIPPI**

The City Council of the City of Pascagoula, Mississippi, met at City Hall in a recessed regular meeting on Monday, August 14, 2017, at 4:15 p.m. Mayor Maxwell called the meeting to order with the following officials present:

Mayor Maxwell welcomed everyone to the meeting. The invocation was given by Councilwoman Colmer. The pledge of allegiance was led by Councilman Wolverton.

Mayor Maxwell stated this meeting was requested by the Council for the presentation of the proposed FY 2017-18 Budget.

Mrs. Liz Ford addressed the Council to present the status report for the LaPointe-Krebs Foundation and asked for their continued support. Mr. Marks Wixon, Executive Director, reported on the history of the restoration project. Mr. Wixon provided a list of the funding sources used during this process. The next phase of the project that includes replacement of the chain-link fence, windows, doors, roof and chimney, is dependent on obtaining the funding. They will be exhausting every effort to find the funding to complete this project with a goal to get the house registered as a National Landmark.

Ms. Jen Dearman, Executive Director of the Pascagoula Redevelopment Authority (PRA), presented the Council with a status report. She explained the PRA is comprised of five (5) members appointed by the City Council and are tasked with developing the Pascagoula Riverfront and the Live Oak property. Also discussed was the budget of the PRA; their completed projects, and an update on the Riverfront Development.

Ms. Jaci Turner, City Engineer, discussed her departmental budget. The Council received handouts. Some of the topics discussed were the bond projects, bulkheads, drainage, library building concerns, and easements and ditches.

The next scheduled Budget meeting will take place on August 16, 2017, at 4:15 p.m.

There being no further business to come before the Council, Councilman Wolverton made a motion to recess the meeting until August 15, 2015, at 6:00 p.m. The motion was seconded by Councilman Burrow and received the following vote: Mayor Maxwell "AYE", Councilmen Colmer "AYE", Jones "AYE", Wolverton "AYE", Burrow "AYE", Parker "AYE", and Tipton "AYE".
