***Lighthouse Park Boat Ramp Closed Saturday for Paddle Battle
Point Park Boat Ramp Access Impacted by Saturday Fishing Tournament***

PASCAGOULA, MISSISSIPPI – (Friday, June 22, 2018) Two scheduled special events TOMORROW, Saturday, June 23, will impact two of the city's four boat ramps for one day only:

Lighthouse Park BOAT RAMP will be CLOSED to vehicles trailering watercraft that are not participating in the 2nd Annual Paddle Battle. This closure is from midnight tonight (Friday) until 2pm. Saturday, following the awards ceremony at Lighthouse Park.

Point Park (aka "The Point") located at the western end of Beach Boulevard is the site of the Pascagoula Men's Club Inshore Challenge & Cobia/Snapper Shoot-Out. Tournament anglers will be launching from Point Park boat ramp at first light and returning throughout the day. The weigh in is from 3-7 pm Saturday. Vehicles trailering watercraft not affiliated with the tournament will find access to the boat ramp heavily impacted throughout the day.

BOTH EVENTS are open to the public to enjoy.

Area boaters who would like to access the beautiful waterways of Pascagoula on Saturday June 23rd are encouraged to use the free city boat ramps at Spanish Fort or River Park.
