12TH ANNUAL HISTORIC CEMETERY TOUR POSTPONED UNTIL FRIDAY
Historic Commission Reschedules Popular Event Due to Anticipated Rains Thursday

(Wednesday, October 24, 2018) – PASCAGOULA, MS With heavy rains expected tomorrow (Thursday) afternoon/evening on the Mississippi Gulf Coast, Pascagoula's Historical Commission has postponed its very popular Historic Cemetery Tour until the following evening, Friday, October 26th. The hours and location remain the same: 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. at Krebs Cemetery, 4602 Fort Street. Parking is on Spanish Avenue and Hickory Street and entry is through the LaPointe-Krebs Museum. The last tour begins at 7:00 p.m.

Titled *Boats, Trains and Planes* this year's reenactment once again features Pascagoula citizens representing famous founding members of east Jackson County, wearing authentic costumes and sharing factual, historic anecdotes. Some of these famous founders portrayed Friday evening will include Miguel Martin Flechas, Sr., Sidoine Krebs, Eugene Gautier, and LTC Leonelle Anthony Bonham, Pascagoula's only Tuskegee Airman.

Researched and written by co-chair Dan Lee, with period costumes by Cheryl Frederic, the annual tour is sponsored by Jackson County Historical and Genealogical Society, LaPointe-Krebs Foundation, Jackson County Board of Supervisors, Main Street Pascagoula, Singing River Genealogical and Local History Library, Kiwanis Club of Mississippi, Brass Hanger Cleaners, Heritage Funeral Home and The City of Pascagoula Historic Preservation Commission.
