**ABSENTEE VOTING DETAILS FOR RUNOFF ELECTION**

*Notice for Those Eligible to Vote in Ward 2 Runoff Special Election*

*Pascagoula, MS – (March 20, 2019) Those residents of Pascagoula who are registered to vote in the upcoming Runoff Special Election in Ward 2 but unable to participate in person at the polling location on Tuesday, April 9, 2019 (Iglesia Bautista Fuente de Vida, 3189 Arlington Street) are reminded of the ABSENTEE VOTING RULES as set forth by Mississippi Statute:*

- *Absentee Voting begins TOMORROW, Thursday, March 21, 2019.*
- Those eligible to vote absentee can obtain an Application and Ballot, and complete it, in person at City Hall – Clerk's Office from 8:00 am – 5:00 p.m.
- Absentee voting dates are Thursday and Friday, March 21-22 (8:00 am-5:00 pm); Monday – Friday, March 25-29 (8:00 am-5:00 pm); Monday – Friday, April 1-5 (8:00 am-5:00 pm); and Saturday, April 6, 8:00 am – 12:00 Noon AT CITY HALL located at 603 Watts Ave.
- You can request an Absentee Ballot and Application be mailed to you, by calling the Clerk's Office at 228-938-6615 or emailing [kkennedy@cityofpascagoula.com](mailto:kkennedy@cityofpascagoula.com).
- You may complete and return the Absentee Ballot and Application BY MAIL, but they MUST BE POSTMARKED no later than MONDAY, APRIL 8, 2019. No applications or ballots for absentee voting will be mailed to a requestor after Friday, April 5, 2019 5:00 p.m.
- State I.D. is required for absentee voting.

We encourage all eligible voters to participate in the Runoff Special Election – Ward 2 on Tuesday, April 9 or by voting absentee during the absentee voting period outlined above.
