



## Individual Initial Public Notice

June 18, 2019

Notification is hereby given to the public of the intent of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to provide assistance to the City of Pascagoula, MS, for the repair of the Point Park piers located in Jackson County, Mississippi, which was damaged during Hurricane Nate as a result of storm surge and flooding.

Due to its location, this project is susceptible to future damages from flooding. Under the President's Executive Order 11988, Floodplain Management, FEMA is required to review the restoration of these facilities for opportunities to relocate it out of the floodplain or to minimize future damage from flooding. Public comment is invited on possible alternatives to these actions, methods to protect this facility and on whether this facility should be restored at all.
