TWO UNRELATED ROAD PROJECTS BEGINNING MONDAY WILL IMPACT PASCAGOULA TRAFFIC
Citizens Alerted to Road Improvements on Hospital Road at Hwy 90 South to Tupelo Ave. and Ballfield Complex Construction on Tucker Ave.

July 26, 2019 – Pascagoula, MS – In an effort to continually inform citizens and visitors of projects impacting our roadways and neighborhoods, the City of Pascagoula announces the following project work in two unrelated areas, both beginning Monday, July 29 in the morning and expected to impact traffic:



- 1) HOSPITAL ROAD – Phase II – This \$1.4 million project will make improvements to the roadway from Tupelo Ave north to Highway 90. Roadwork is projected to last 7 to 8 months, and will include installation of sidewalks and needed repairs to infrastructure; water/sewer improvements, road widening with curbs, and lighting.

This project is expected to cause some traffic delays, although crews will be rerouting/managing traffic and working to minimize impact to vehicular, pedestrian and bike traffic. No road closures are expected at this time, and crews will be working to ensure access to businesses along the route that may be impacted.

- 2) MUNICIPAL BALLFIELDS – The construction at the new municipal ballfield complex continues, with Tucker Ave. being closed beginning Monday. Crews will be working to have the street re-opened by Monday, August 5th. Access to school driveways will be provided. This is part of the current phase of the project that is slated for a spring 2020 completion, with a \$10.7 million cost funded by local taxpayers through a recreation bond approved in 2017.

Both projects' completion dates are weather-dependent, and citizens are reminded to please drive carefully in construction zones and follow the instructions of project workers who may be slowing or diverting traffic.
