**Pascagoula City Council COVID-19 2nd Amended Resolution 04/07/2020**

PASCAGOULA, MISSISSIPPI –

The Pascagoula City Council met on Tuesday, April 7, 2020, at 6:00 pm to discuss potential mitigation in light of COVID-19 for retail businesses deemed “Essential Businesses or Operations” as defined by Executive Order No. 1463. At the meeting, the following regulations were agreed upon:

1. The City Council of Pascagoula, Mississippi hereby adopts and implements the following regulations, which shall become effective at 11:59 p.m. CT on April 8, 2020:
2. Retail businesses deemed “Essential Businesses or Operations” as defined by Executive Order No. 1463, including, but not limited to, grocery stores, supermarkets, convenience stores, hardware and building materials stores, automotive sales and repairs stores, pharmacies, feed stores, and office supply stores, shall ensure the following:
  - (a) That for every 1,000 square feet of gross building footage, only one (1) customer shall be permitted in any such business’s building (this limitation shall not apply to the business’s employees); and
  - (b) That customers queueing in line or otherwise congregating outside of such businesses shall remain six (6) feet apart from others.
