



GENERAL INFORMATION

Goals of the Pascagoula Mayor's Youth Council:

- Give students an understanding of how city government works
- Inspire Pascagoula youth to take an active role in their community

Membership Requirements

Each member will be required to:

- Take the oath of office pledging to support the PMYC mission and adhere to code of conduct
- Complete eight (8) hours of community service per semester
- Attend at least two (2) City Council meetings throughout the year

Duties and Responsibilities

- PMYC membership terms are one (1) year terms following the academic school year
- PMYC members will meet once a month at City Hall immediately following the end of school
- PMYC members will present semi-annual reports to the City Council

Executive Committee

The Executive Committee's purpose is to plan the overall direction of the Youth Council throughout the year. The Executive Committee works together under the leadership of the Coordinator to form goals, timelines, and to manage the implementation of such.

- **Mayor:** Leads the organization, presides over meetings, and helps create the agenda. Presents semi-annual reports to the Pascagoula City Council on PMYC service projects, leadership training, etc.
- **Vice-Mayor:** Serves as second in command for the Mayor, and fills in during the Mayor's absence. Responsible for creating semi-annual Pascagoula City Council reports.
- **Clerk of Council:** Keeps the minutes of each meeting and posts the minutes to the Youth Council.
- **City Manager:** Responsible for coordinating and finding volunteer opportunities for the Youth Council. Keeps records of all members' service hours.
