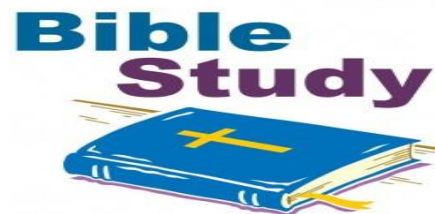
Gym will be limited to two people at a time. This is necessary to maintain social distancing.
