Ingalls Avenue Road Work to Resume in October

PASCAGOULA, Miss. – The second phase of construction on the Ingalls Avenue road improvement project is scheduled to resume the week of October 4. The contractor will resume the removal of existing infrastructure in preparation for the installation of new water mains, sewer lines, and storm drains.

The work will take place on Ingalls Avenue between Pascagoula Street and Market Street. This section of Ingalls Avenue will be closed to through traffic. Access for residents and businesses on the affected section of Ingalls will generally be permitted. The contractor will coordinate with each residence/business if access across their drive must be temporarily closed.

Much of the construction will require partial lane closures, however, occasionally the entire width of the street will have to be closed. The preferred detour routes are Communy Avenue and Beach Boulevard. Residents and businesses are asked for their patience while construction is ongoing.

This is the second phase of a major road improvement project on Ingalls Avenue between Desoto Street and Market Street. The project consists of replacing water mains, sewer lines, and storm drains. Ingalls Avenue will be repaved and new ADA compliant sidewalks will be put in.
