Mayor Maxwell requested that the Council consider the following Proclamation regarding Tropical Storm Isaac:

**PROCLAMATION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF PASCAGOULA, MISSISSIPPI, PURSUANT
TO THE MISSISSIPPI EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT
LAW OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY AS A RESULT
OF THE IMPENDING ARRIVAL OF A TROPICAL STORM
ISAAC AS OF 8/26/12**

WHEREAS, as of the time of the adoption of this proclamation Tropical Storm Isaac is moving northerly toward the southern coast of the United States, including the coast of Mississippi; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that this Tropical Storm will reach hurricane strength prior to landfall somewhere on the northern Gulf Coast in close proximity to the City of Pascagoula; and

WHEREAS, in view of the impending arrival of the Tropical Storm Isaac, it is appropriate to declare a state of emergency pursuant to the Mississippi Emergency Management Law (Sections 33-15-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972); and

WHEREAS, we find and determine that the public interest requires that we proclaim a state of local emergency as authorized by said law;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
PASCAGOULA, MISSISSIPPI**, hereby proclaims that a local emergency exists in the

City as of 4:30 P.M., August 26, 2012, and hereby declares that the City shall exercise all powers and authority granted to it under said Mississippi Emergency Management Law to deal with such emergency.

IT IS FURTHER PROCLAIMED that this state of local emergency shall continue for thirty days unless extended or terminated prior to the expiration of thirty days.

The above Proclamation was introduced by Councilman Corder, seconded for adoption by Councilman Wolverton, and received the following vote: Mayor Maxwell "AYE". Councilmen Abston "AYE", Corder "AYE", Milstead "AYE", Stallworth "ABSENT", Tillman "ABSENT", and Wolverton "AYE". The Mayor then declared the Proclamation adopted on the 26th day of August, 2012.

Councilman Wolverton made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Councilman Corder and received the following vote: Mayor Maxwell "AYE". Councilmen Abston "AYE", Corder "AYE", Milstead "AYE", Stallworth "ABSENT", Tillman "ABSENT", and Wolverton "AYE".
