

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF PASCAGOULA, MISSISSIPPI
ADVERTISING CITY RESOURCES WITH CONTRIBUTION TO MAINSTREET TO
SUPPORT BEACH PARK ELECTRICAL UPGRADES**

WHEREAS, Beach Park has become the premiere destination on the Mississippi Coast for supporting many major events in our community; and

WHEREAS, with the continued growth of Cruisin' the Coast and other major events at Beach Park, it is necessary to update Beach Park's electrical systems to support vendors and citizens that utilize the park during these events; and

WHEREAS, Mainstreet has obtained a quote from City Electric Supply for \$19,559.46 to provide the materials necessary for the electrical upgrades at Beach Park; and

WHEREAS, Mainstreet may incur additional costs for conduit, wire lengths, and other materials associated with this project; and

WHEREAS, Mainstreet has agreed to pay the quote submitted by City Electric Supply for the electrical upgrades at Beach Park; and

WHEREAS, Mainstreet has requested that the City of Pascagoula contribute \$9,779.73 towards said upgrades; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Mississippi Code Section 17-3-1, the City Council may expend moneys of the City of Pascagoula for the purpose of advertising and bringing into favorable notice the opportunities, possibilities and resources of the City of Pascagoula; and

WHEREAS, contributing \$9,779.73 to Mainstreet to support electrical upgrades at Beach Park will encourage expanded activities at Beach Park, drawing more visitors to the City of Pascagoula and promoting the City of Pascagoula's economy and development.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of Pascagoula, Mississippi hereby adopts the forgoing recitals as its findings.

SECTION 2. That the City Council of Pascagoula, Mississippi hereby approves contributing \$9,779.73 to Mainstreet to support electrical upgrades at Beach Park and finds that such a contribution will bring into favorable notice the opportunities, possibilities, and resources of the City of Pascagoula.
