

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN JACKSON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI AND
THE CITY OF PASCAGOULA, MISSISSIPPI
FOR ASSISTANCE WITH INSTALLATION OF A GRAVEL
PARKING LOT AT THE PASCAGOULA SPORTS COMPLEX

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Jackson County, Mississippi (“County”) is authorized, in its discretion, to provide county equipment, manpower and other county services and resources to municipalities within the County pursuant to House Bill 35 (Local & Private, 2002 Regular Session); and

WHEREAS, assisting the City of Pascagoula (“City”) with the establishment of a gravel parking lot in the southwest corner of the Pascagoula Sports Complex (the “Project”) is in the best interest of the citizens and taxpayers of Jackson County in that it will provide convenient parking for the public when attending sporting events at the Pascagoula Sports Complex; and

WHEREAS, the County and City desire to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”) regarding assistance with the Project within the City, as permitted pursuant to House Bill 35, subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The estimated total Project cost is One Hundred Thirty Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$130,000.00).
2. The County shall provide the surveying and engineering work (in house) for said work.
3. The Jackson County Road Department will provide the labor and equipment to perform the earthwork and gravel installation necessary to complete the construction of the Project.
4. The City shall pay for 1/3 of the total estimated Project cost, Forty-Three Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-Three and 33/100 Dollars (\$43,333.33).
5. The County will provide funding for the remaining Project costs.
6. The City shall provide its share of the estimated total Project cost to the County within forty-five (45) days of receiving a copy of the fully executed copy of the MOU from the County.
7. The County does hereby certify the funds it receives from the City shall be used exclusively for the Project.
8. This MOU shall be effective upon execution by both parties and shall remain in effect for a term of one year (12 months), unless terminated earlier in writing by both parties. The term may be extended prior to expiration upon the written agreement of both parties.
9. Attached hereto as Attachment A and incorporated herein by reference is a resolution from the City supporting the request.

This document constitutes the entire agreement between the parties hereto and cannot be amended or modified in any respect except by an amendment in writing by both parties.

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF PASCAGOULA, MISSISSIPPI
REQUESTING JACKSON COUNTY ASSISTANCE FOR INSTALLATION OF
PARKING LOT AT SPORTS COMPLEX**

WHEREAS, Jackson County Supervisor Ken Taylor and Jackson County Supervisor Ennit Morris have offered to combine their discretionary funds to support the establishment of a parking lot in the southwest corner of the Pascagoula Sports Complex; and

WHEREAS, Jackson County is offering to have the County to perform earthwork and gravel installation to form the parking lot at the southwest corner of the Pascagoula Sports Complex; and

WHEREAS, the total estimated cost to perform this work will be \$130,000.00; and

WHEREAS, as part of the County performing earthwork and gravel installation they would like for the City to pay for 1/3 of the total cost of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of Pascagoula, Mississippi hereby adopts the foregoing recitals as its finding.

SECTION 2. That the City Council of Pascagoula, Mississippi hereby approves the request to Jackson County for performing earthwork and gravel installation at the southwest corner of the Sports Complex.

SECTION 3. That the City Council of Pascagoula, Mississippi hereby approves funding 1/3 of the total estimated project that will be performed by the County.
