

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF PASCAGOULA, MISSISSIPPI  
APPROVING LICENSE AGREEMENT FOR HOTEL WHISKEY PARKING**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Pascagoula owns certain rights-of-way in downtown Pascagoula along Delmas Avenue; and

**WHEREAS**, Revival Property 111, LLC is developing a property at 650 Delmas Avenue that will include a hotel and residential units; and

**WHEREAS**, as part of this development, Revival Property 111, LLC proposes to reconfigure parking spaces in the City's right-of-way along the north margin of Delmas Avenue; and

**WHEREAS**, specifically, Revival Property 111, LLC proposes to reconfigure parking spaces to allow for a loading/unloading area, ADA-compliant parking, and parking with chargers for electric vehicles; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to said proposal, all the parking spaces reconfigured by Revival Property 111, LLC shall remain accessible to the general public; and

**WHEREAS**, allowing the reconfiguration of these six parking spaces will benefit the City of Pascagoula by facilitating this development and promoting economic development in downtown Pascagoula; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Mississippi Code Section 17-3-1, the proposed reconfiguration of these parking spaces by Revival Property 111, LLC will serve the purpose of advertising and bringing into favorable notice the opportunities, possibilities and resources of Pascagoula; and

**WHEREAS**, the attached revocable License Agreement for Parking will allow for the efficient utilization and operation of the subject hotel and residential units while, at the same time, protect the City's interests in downtown Pascagoula; and

**WHEREAS**, approving and executing the attached License Agreement for Parking is in the City's best interest.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1:** The City Council of Pascagoula hereby adopts the foregoing recitals as its findings.

**SECTION 2:** The City Council of Pascagoula hereby approves the attached License Agreement for Parking and authorizes the Mayor to execute the same.
