

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF PASCAGOULA, MISSISSIPPI
REQUESTING JACKSON COUNTY FUNDING ASSISTANCE TO PURCHASE
BOLLARDS FOR BEACH BOULEVARD BEACH ENTRANCES**

WHEREAS, Jackson County Government maintains Pascagoula Beach;

WHEREAS, Jackson County is able to provide maintenance to Pascagoula Beach by driving their equipment through the beach access driveway areas;

WHEREAS, there are a total of 24 beach bollards that are missing from the beach access driveway areas;

WHEREAS, these bollards are utilized to stop citizens from driving onto Pascagoula Beach with their vehicles;

WHEREAS, the City of Pascagoula has consulted with Jackson County Government on what bollards would be appropriate to purchase to improve access for Jackson County Maintenance staff;

WHEREAS, the City of Pascagoula has obtained a quote from Reliance Foundry in the amount of \$20,902.00 to purchase the 24 bollards;

WHEREAS, the bollards quoted by Reliance Foundry are the only bollards that will fit the existing inserts for the bollards;

WHEREAS, because of the characteristics outlined above, the bollards are considered single source items pursuant to Mississippi Code Section 31-7-13(m)(viii);

WHEREAS, pursuant to Mississippi Code Section 31-7-13(m)(viii), single source items, such as the bollards quoted by Reliance Foundry, are not subject to bidding requirements;

WHEREAS, the City of Pascagoula is requesting that the Jackson County Board of Supervisors provide \$20,902.00 in funding to assist the City of Pascagoula in purchasing the 24 bollards from Reliance Foundry.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of Pascagoula, Mississippi hereby adopts the forgoing recitals as its findings.

SECTION 2. That the City Council of Pascagoula, Mississippi hereby approves the request to Jackson County for funding assistance to purchase 24 beach bollards for \$20,902.00.
