The Mississippi Gulf Coast Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) held its quarterly Transportation Policy Committee meeting on December 8, 2022. At this meeting, the MPO approved an amendment to the Gulf Coast FY 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to add a project to improve CSX railroad crossings at Pascagoula Street, Magnolia Street, and Frederic Street. The MPO allocated \$1,200,000 in Small Urban STBG funds for this project. A required public review and comment period was provided for this amendment to the TIP.



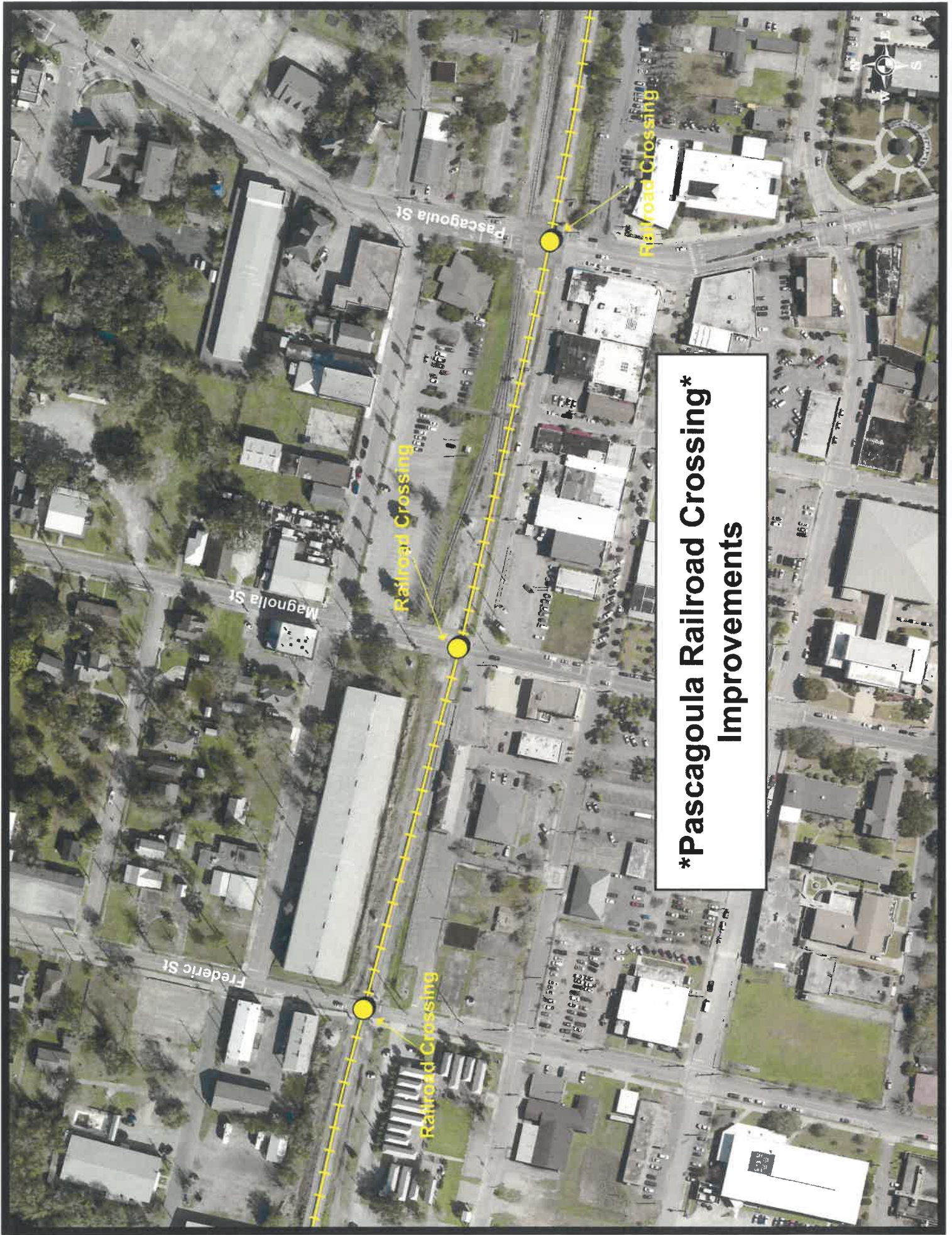
