Notice is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Pascagoula will meet at City Hall on Monday, December 3, 2018, at 6:00 p.m. for the purpose of discussing the potential sale of its natural gas system.

We, the undersigned members of the City Council of the City of Pascagoula, MS, do hereby waive further notice of and consent to a special call meeting of the City Council at 6:00 p.m. on December 3, 2018, in the City Hall of the City for the purpose hereinabove stated.

This notice and consent is being given pursuant to Section 21-9-39 of the Mississippi Code of 1972 as annotated and amended. A copy of this notice and consent to a special meeting shall be sent by the City Clerk to local media and posted as required by law.

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO SELL NATURAL GAS SYSTEM

On November 6, 2018 the City of Pascagoula (the “City”) signed a letter of intent (the “LOI”) with CenterPoint Energy Resources Corp. d/b/a CenterPoint Energy Mississippi Gas (“CenterPoint”) expressing the parties’ mutual intention to execute a definitive asset purchase agreement for the City’s sale of its natural gas public utility system and all real property, easements and rights-of-way used in connection therewith (the “Gas System”) to CenterPoint for \$3 million, subject to certain terms and conditions stated in the LOI. The LOI is available for viewing in the offices of the City Clerk at 603 Watts Ave., Pascagoula, MS 39567. CenterPoint is a public utility providing natural gas service to over 120,000 customers in Mississippi, and is regulated by the Mississippi Public Service Commission (“MPSC”). Upon such an acquisition, CenterPoint would provide natural gas service to the current customers of the Gas System consistent with its tariffs on file with the MPSC. This Notice is to be published once weekly for three consecutive weeks, with the last publication occurring on November 22, 2018. Under Miss. Code Ann. § 21-27-33, the City may sell the Gas System to CenterPoint, unless within ten days from the last publication, a petition signed by not less than 20% of the City’s qualified voters is filed, objecting to and protesting against such sale. Should such a petition be filed, then a special election would be held for the purpose of determining whether a majority of those voting in such election shall vote for or against such a sale.
