Governor Reeves Issues Executive Order No. 1463

PASCAGOULA, MISSISSIPPI –

In Executive Order No. 1463, dated March 24, 2020, the Governor of the State of Mississippi ordered that, effective immediately, restaurants and bars may remain open and provide dine-in service, provided that they “allow no more than 10 people to be gathered in a single space at the same time where individuals are in seated or otherwise in close proximity to each other.” As a result, restaurants and bars in the City of Pascagoula are advised to follow the guidance set forth in Executive Order No. 1463, which supersedes the City Council’s Resolution Enacting Regulations to Protect Life and Property and to Prevent the Introduction and Spread of a Contagious or Infectious Diseases, which was entered on March 21, 2020.
