**Masks are now required to enter City of Pascagoula buildings**

PASCAGOULA, Miss. – A few City of Pascagoula employees have tested positive for COVID-19.

In an effort to keep employees and the public safe, face masks will now be required inside **all** City of Pascagoula buildings. If a person is not wearing a face mask, he/she will not be allowed to enter the building.

Municipal Court hearings scheduled for July 8<sup>th</sup>, 2020 have been canceled. Those who had court hearings for this date will be notified of the rescheduled dates.

The Police Department is closed to the public on Monday July 6<sup>th</sup>, 2020 for sanitization purposes.

Additional testing for City of Pascagoula employees is ongoing.

Citizens are asked to refrain from coming to city buildings unless absolutely necessary. City Council meetings are streamed online on the City of Pascagoula YouTube channel.

We appreciate the public's cooperation as we all work together to slow the spread of COVID-19.
