

# Curbside Cleanliness Guidelines

## Ordinance Sec. 70-11.

### Materials not to be collected by City:

- B. Building materials. Building material resulting from construction, demolition, repairs, or remodeling of any building or structure.
- C. Tree Trimmings. Tree trimmings produced by tree surgeons, landscape or tree service contractors, pulp wood cutters or other commercial worker.

**The items listed above shall be the duty and responsibility of contractors or property owner for the removal and proper disposal of such materials.**



**By adhering to the City of Pascagoula Code of Ordinances, we can work together to prevent curbside waste problems.**



## City Ordinance Sec. 70-3.

### Refuse to be drained of liquids; Placement of bulky items; hazardous waste

- A. Refuse shall be drained of all liquids and deposited in containers. Bulky items, such as furniture, appliances, yard toys and unbundled or uncontainerized tree trimming shall be placed at roadway with trash container.
- B. Hazardous waste shall not be collected by the City nor shall such waste be placed in containers for collection by the City.

## City Ordinance Sec. 70-8.

### Depositing upon public property, or on premises or in containers of another.

- B. It shall be **unlawful** for any person to place to deposit any refuse or litter upon the property of another person or upon a street, alley, park, or other public property, or in any canal, waterway, pool or the like, or in any container upon which another person has paid the collection fee.

**Hazardous waste may be disposed of during the annual Household Hazardous Waste Day hosted by the Jackson County Solid Waste Department.**

## City Ordinance Sec. 70-2. Refuse, bulk and detachable containers.

- J. Containers to be kept on person's property. Containers for refuse shall be kept upon property owned, occupied or controlled by the person who accumulates such refuse. Containers for refuse shall *not* be placed at the curb for collection *earlier than 10:00 am* on the day before collection is scheduled and shall be removed and returned to a storage point on the owner's property behind the front plane of the owner's residence, or in an enclosed area, **not later than 10:00 pm** on the day of collection.

## Collection Days

Bulky waste is collected on the same day as regular pickup. Any items that will fit should be placed in the trash can. Any items that are too large should be placed to the side of the can for collection.

### Disposal Alternatives

The City of Pascagoula Drop Off Center is located next to the Building Department at 4015 14th Street. Residents may bring yard waste, white goods, and bulky waste. No construction material, tires, batteries, electronic waste, or food waste will be accepted. The 14th Street Drop Off Center is open from 8:00 am—5:00 pm Monday through Friday. Construction waste may be taken to the landfill on Seaman Road or Waste Pro.
